STEPHEN MINISTRY TRAINING BEGINS SEPTEMBER 15

Every day you see people who are hurting: those who have lost a job, lost a loved one, gone through a divorce, or are battling a serious illness. Stephen Ministers are God's representatives who bring his love to those who are hurting. God is waiting to make a difference in their lives through you!

Lutheran Social Services has been a member of the Stephen Ministry program for over 20 years. Stephen Ministers receive 50 hours of training in helping skills like listening, feeling, confidentiality and boundaries. When training is completed, a Stephen Minister is assigned to work with one person who is going through a difficult time in their life. They meet for about one hour a week. The Stephen Minister also attends Supervision classes twice a month. A new training class will begin on September 15, 2011. Classes will be held at Memorial Lutheran Church in Shippensburg on Thursday mornings from 9:30 AM to 12:00 PM. Leaders for the class will be the Rev. Brenda Kiser and Carol Hughes.
